

His new book addresses the current climate as the country gears up for the 2024 presidential election. Arguing that the United States is best described as an empire, with distinctive similarities to imperial powers of the past, Watts lays out the historical, political, socioeconomic and geopolitical reasons why the American Empire might collapse sooner rather than later, with huge domestic and global consequences.

Confronted by problems at home and rivals abroad, America has its work cut out if it is to avoid or at least postpone this fate. Its citizens deserve better – better institutions, greater social harmony, more reliable media, cleaner politicians. *The End of the American Empire* examines these topics with bracing honesty and compassionate concern, seeking to generate healthy debate and necessary change.

"The decline of American influence, and the end of the American Empire, is inevitable like that of all empires before it," explains Watts. "But the crucial questions are about the timing, the suffering that might be involved or avoided, and how the world will look in the aftermath."

Watts does not see civil war or social collapse as certainties, but as risks that must be acknowledged and addressed. Troubled by political dysfunction, deteriorating international relations, rising inequality and deep domestic divisions, he ends the book by appealing to the positive values and emotions that can help the country to heal: optimism, understanding, love and compassion.


